This term we are going to be covering the following topic:

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| Science | Children are exploring evolution and inheritance this half term. They will look at how human beings have developed over time and come to understand what fossils can tell us about many living things that existed thousands of years ago. They will look at earliest forms of humans and understand how they lived and survived on our planet. |
| History | This half term children are exploring entertainment and leisure throughout history. They will learn what activities and past times people did from the Victorian period through to the modern age and the impact that the World Wars had on society and culture. |
| RE | Children are learning about the story of Daniel. They will examine the story and be able to recall and retell it in their own words. Children will also look at significant people of faith who took great risks to fight for what they believe in. |
| PSHE | This half term children are looking at relationships. They will explore what comprises of a healthy relationship and consider the characteristics of toxic one. Children will also come to analyse the relationship they have with themselves and think about relationships in the wider context through online communities and social platforms. |
| Art | This half term children will explore the exciting world of street art; they will look at the works of famous graffiti artists such as Banksy and plan and design their own graffiti style artwork. Children will use a variety of tools to help them develop their sketching techniques. |
| Computing | Children are learning how to create spreadsheets this half term and will come to learn how to collate and interpret a variety of data. They will come to understand the different formulaic expressions that are frequently used within Excel. |
| Music | This half term children are singing and making their own music using the 'music and me' as a stimulus. They will build on their skills of performing and playing musical instruments to learn a new piece of music. |
